

## The Waste Electronic & Electrical Equipment Directive (WEEE)

On 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014, The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013 became UK law. The aim of this updated legislation is to minimise the environmental impact of end-of-life electrical and electronic equipment by reuse or recycling, rather than disposing in landfill.

If the product you have purchased, its packaging, or its accompanying documentation displays the crossed out whee-lie-bin symbol, you should ensure that it is not placed in general municipal waste at the end of its life.
